

Consent Form

Emergency Policy:

In a case of a medical emergency JIT Chabad reserves the right to seek medical treatment for your child and the right to transport your child to an appropriate facility such as an emergency room or hospital.

Withdrawal Policy:

There are absolutely no refunds for camp payments. Parents will be charged for all the weeks they have registered for online. No exceptions will be made.

Registration Fee and tuition payment

The Registration Fee is as well as all camp payments are non-refundable

Wellness Policy:

Parents must keep children home for 24 hours after a fever subsides or 24 hours after the start of antibiotics. Children cannot be sent to school after administering over the counter fever reducers. We reserve the right to send children home whenever we feel necessary – if they are deemed a risk to others in school. You will receive a Feel Better note whenever your child is sent home. Instructions on that note must be put in place before sending a child back to school.

Discipline Policy:

Positive discipline is used to motivate, encourage, support, foster love of learning, lead to self-discipline, increase competence and confidence in all students. Children under the care of JIT Chabad shall not be subject to discipline which is severe, humiliating or frightening. Discipline shall not be associated with food, rest or toileting. Spanking or any other form of physical punishment is never used.

Outside Food Policy:

My child may participate in birthday parties, holiday programs and any other programming in which special food is served from outside.

Additional Fees:

I understand that in the case of a returned check I am responsible for the **\$10 return fee**. Any tuition paid late is subject to a **\$100 late fee**. For a late pickup from Aftercare (after 4:45pm) I am responsible for a **\$10 late fee**. For a late pickup on Friday (after 3:00pm) I am responsible for a **\$50 late fee**.

Vaccinations:

Per Florida law current State of Florida medical forms or exemption thereof, for my child are on file with JIT Chabad. I understand that JIT Chabad is not responsible for and is not liable for any injuries or illnesses based on my decisions regarding vaccinations or election not to vaccinate – including but not limited to: tetanus, measles, chicken pox and any other communicable diseases.
